**NOTICE IN TERMS OF TRANSFER OF ASSET REGULATION 9 OF THE MUNICIPAL FINANCE MANAGEMENT ACT 56 OF 2003 – METROPOLITAN TRADING COMPANY**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** in terms of Transfer of Asset Regulation 9 of the Local Government: Municipal Finance Management Act, No. 56 of 2003 that Metropolitan Trading Company (“**MTC**”) intends transferring the Johannesburg Broadband Network Asset.

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** in accordance with Section 21 and Section 21A of the Local Government Municipal Systems Act, No. 32 of 2000 that –

- (a) A proposal to transfer or dispose of the MTC broadband network together with an information statement referred to in regulation 8(3)(b) is hereby made public;
- (b) The local community and other interested persons are invited to submit comments or representations to the City of Johannesburg (MTC’s parent Municipality) in respect of the proposed information statement to the Group Chief Executive Officer under reference “Information Statement,” 10<sup>th</sup> Floor, 222 Smit Street, Braamfontein, or by email at [mtc-ebm@joburg.org.za](mailto:mtc-ebm@joburg.org.za) by no later than 90 (ninety) days from the date of this advertisement.
- (c) Persons who are physically disabled or unable to write but need to participate in the process may present themselves during office hours at BraamPark, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, Forum 4, 33 Hoofd Street, Braamfontein (hereinafter referred to as MTC offices) where a staff member will assist them to transcribe the relevant comments or representations.
- (d) A hard copy of the information statement will also be available for inspection during MTC’s office hours at MTC offices.
